

Global Access Fee Student Authorization Form

If you plan to study abroad while enrolled in Virginia State University, you will need to have a current U.S. Passport. The *Global Access Fee* (\$135) is a one-time charge that covers the cost of an ADULT U.S. Passport. Once this fee is paid in advance, you will not need to pay the application fee when you attend a *VSU Passport Day* event and apply in person for your US Passport. Just bring your documents and ID!

However, you must <u>voluntarily</u> elect to have the *Global Access Fee* charged to your student account. To do so, simply complete and sign this form. To be eligible for voluntary billing of this fee, you must (1) be a currently enrolled incoming or returning VSU student and (2) be a US Citizen. The *Global Access Fee* is <u>NOT</u> available to international students/other non-US citizens. This fee can only be used during an oncampus VSU Passport Day event.

- If I do not apply for a U.S. Passport during a VSU Passport Day event during the academic year in which the *Global Access Fee* is billed, the \$135 charge will be reversed by the Office for International Education.
- If I fail to show up for my confirmed appointment on a VSU Passport Day event, I understand that the \$135 application fee paid on my behalf will not be refunded.
